UNITED WAY INVESTS IN 45 PROGRAMS AND 14 AGENCIES IN RICHLAND COUNTY. THE FOLLOWING ARE SOME OF THE MANY IMPACTFUL OUTCOMES UNITED WAY DOLLARS HAVE BEEN ABLE TO PROVIDE

FACT: PROVIDED 1,560 HOURS OF SERVICE TO OVER 4,989 STUDENTS FROM LOCAL SCHOOLS FOR DRUG AND ALCOHOL PREVENTION

-THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER PROVIDED EMERGENCY HOUSING TO **66** WOMEN AND **64** CHILDREN IN RICHLAND COUNTY
-21,059 MEALS WERE SERVED TO CHILDREN AT HAPPY HOLLOW DAY CAMP AND THROUGH THE AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM AT **THE FRIENDLY HOUSE**

-AMERICAN RED CROSS, EAST CENTRAL OHIO REGION INSTALLED **144** FREE SMOKE ALARMS IN RICHLAND COUNTY RESIDENCES AND PROVIDED THEM WITH HOME FIRE PREPAREDNESS EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS

-WAYFINDERS OHIO PROVIDED **57,303** MEALS AND **19,101** NIGHTS OF LODGING TO **582** UNIQUE CLIENTS

-198 HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED HOUSING ASSISTANCE THROUGH **CATHOLIC CHARITIES**

-THE CHAP HUB SERVED **240** AT-RISK CLIENTS WHO DID NOT HAVE ANY OTHER SOURCE OF PAYMENT. THROUGH HOME AND TELEPHONIC VISITS, THIS OPENS THE DOOR FOR NECESSARY SERVICES TO REACH CLIENTS WHO ARE OTHERWISE ISOLATED DUE TO CULTURAL, GEOGRAPHIC, AND ECONOMIC BARRIERS

-THE BIG RED BOOKSHELF PROJECT DISTRIBUTED OVER **12,000** BOOKS THROUGHOUT THE COMMUNITY IN 2022 AND ENROLLED **275** CHILDREN IN THE READY4K PROGRAM

-THIRD STREET FAMILY HEALTH SERVICES SERVED **79** RICHLAND COUNTY PATIENTS BY OFFERING A VARIETY OF ITEMS DEPENDING ON THE PATIENT'S NEEDS. DISTRIBUTED **58** POSTPARTUM GIFT BAGS (21 BAGS FOR BREASTFEEDING FAMILIES AND 37 BAGS FOR FORMULA-FEEDING FAMILIES), **13** CAR SEATS, AND **9** STROLLERS
-UNITED WAY SUMMER OF CARING PROGRAMS IN 2022 SAW VOLUNTEERS FROM OVER **30** LOCAL COMPANIES AND PROVIDED HUNDREDS OF VOLUNTEER HOURS OF SERVICE TO **OVER A DOZEN** LOCAL NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

-RAEMELTON PROVIDED **14** SCHOLARSHIPS WITH UNITED WAY ALLOCATIONS FUNDING TO STUDENTS OF THE MADISON SCHOOL DISTRICT MULTIPLE-SPECIAL NEEDS CLASSROOMS

-MID-OHIO YOUTH MENTORING SERVED **334** YOUTH THROUGH THEIR MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

-GIRL SCOUTS OF OHIO'S HEARTLAND WAS ABLE TO PROVIDE 111 GIRLS IN RICHLAND COUNTY WITH HANDS-ON COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMMING
